

CONSTRUCTION (DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT) REGULATIONS CDM²⁰⁰⁷

HEALTH AND SAFETY STATEMENT

The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 1994 came into effect from 31 March 1995 and were superseded by the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007. It is the policy of J Breheny Contractors Ltd to observe and fulfill the duties placed upon it by these regulations.

J Breheny Contractors Ltd will accept an appointment of Principal Contractor under these regulations for a contract and undertake those duties. The company has successfully undertaken the role of Principal Contractor on most of the contracts awarded them since the regulations came into force in April 1995.

With particular regard to the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations, one of our senior staff, Mr G Edgar C.Eng., M.I.C.E. has been given the responsibility for observance and implementation of these regulations and production of the necessary Health and Safety Plans and Files.

Our Company produces site specific Risk Assessments, COSHH Assessments for all contracts, and Construction Health and Safety Plans developed from the Pre-tender Health & Safety Plan when acting as Principal Contractor. Health and Safety is an integral part of our operating procedures.

Training is given to all employees relevant to their occupation and duties. A detailed training register is maintained (copy available upon request).

It is the Company's policy to promote Health and Safety on all sites and amongst all employees. To effect this, a copy of the Company Health and Safety Policy is issued to all employees and all site personnel are given general site safety awareness training.

A Company Director together with the Company Safety Officer has the responsibility for the policy and implementation of all safety matters whilst Contracts Managers have the responsibility for the implementation on construction sites.

This Policy is to be reviewed no later than 31st December 2010.
